



**Parental Permission Agreement (for non-WSUV patrons who are under 18)**

Dear Parents,

Washington State University Vancouver Library welcomes use by you and your children. The Library's primary mission is to serve the students, faculty and staff of WSU Vancouver. Our materials are selected for use in the WSU Vancouver curriculum. It is not a public library collection. I feel it is important for you to know that there may be information, both in the Library and through the internet connections here, that you might feel is inappropriate for your child's use. This makes it extremely important that you and your child understand the following:

1. The WSU Vancouver Library collection and workstation usage is only monitored for appropriate use not for specific content.
2. When workstations are in high demand, community users may be asked to surrender their use of computers to WSU
3. Children under 12 years should be accompanied by a parent.

Please read the above information and discuss it with your child, then fill out the attached form, sign it, and return it to the Library. Your child should also sign it, indicating an acceptance of our use policy. He/she will then be issued a card that will be kept at the Reference Desk. Your child can let the person at the Desk know that they have a card on file. *This agreement will need to be renewed each year.* With responsible use, our materials can be a valuable learning resource for your child.
